It is the order of the court that you will, during your release on your own recognizance while under supervised release comply in all respects with the following terms and conditions:

1. You must appear in court whenever directed by the Court;
2. You must obey all laws applicable to you;
3. You must reside at _____, when released from custody, and notify the Hawaii Intake Service Center at 323-4563as directed if you decide to change your address;
4. You must not leave the island of Hawaii without first obtaining the approval of the court;
5. You must report to the Hawaii Intake Service Center whenever directed by your supervising ISC worker;
6. You must actively cooperate and participate in any established program of the Hawaii Intake Service Center.


YOU SHALL:

1. ___ Not own, use, or possess alcohol, illicit drugs, or drug paraphernalia.
2. ___ Submit to random drug & alcohol testing as directed by the Hawaii Intake Service Center. You must submit a urine sample within two (2) hours of receiving notice from the Hawaii Intake Service Center.
3. ___ Obtain a substance abuse assessment within two (2) weeks of your release and follow any recommended treatment until clinically discharged. You shall be responsible for costs of the assessment and/or treatment program.
4. ___ Obtain a mental health/anger management assessment within one (1) week, follow any recommended treatment, at your own expense, and take all medications as prescribed, until clinically discharged.
5. ___ Seek and maintain gainful employment and/or enroll in an education or vocational training program.
6. ___ Not contact complainant/victim/witness _____, except through counsel for advocacy purposes.
7. ___ Not harass/annoy/abuse/alarm the complainant/victim/witness _____ during the pendency of this case.
8. ___ Remain 300 yards away from the complainant/victim/witness _____, his/her residence and employment.
9. ___ Not own, use, or possess firearms, other deadly weapons, or live ammunition.
10. ___ Enter at the earliest possible time into the _____ Program and remain there until clinically discharged.
11. ___ Comply with the following curfew: _____, to be monitored through electronic monitoring, and in compliance with the Hawaii Intake Service Center's Terms and Conditions of Electronic Monitoring.

12. Other: Make a personal check-in with HISC within 48 hrs. of release.

You are advised that failure to comply with any of the foregoing terms and conditions of release on your own recognizance while under Supervised Release may mean that the Court may revoke the agreement of release on your own recognizance and issue a warrant for your arrest.

Bail jumping in the first degree:

- (1) A person commits the offense of bail jumping in the first degree if, having been released from custody by court order with or without bail, upon conditions that s/he will subsequently appear as ordered in connection with a charge of having committed a class A, B, or C felony, s/he intentionally fails to appear as ordered.
- (2) Bail jumping in the first degree is a class C felony.

Bail jumping in the second degree:

- (1) A person commits the offense of bail jumping in the second degree if, having been released from custody by court order with or without bail, upon condition that s/he will subsequently appear as ordered in connection with a charge of having committed a misdemeanor or a petty misdemeanor, s/he intentionally fails to appear as ordered.
- (2) Bail jumping in the second degree is a misdemeanor.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT BY DEFENDANT

The foregoing Terms and Conditions of Supervised Release and the offense of Bail Jumping, Section 710-1024,1025, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended, have been explained to me and I fully understand them and agree in every particular to abide by them. I understand that in the event I violate any of the conditions of release, the Court may issue a warrant for my arrest. I am also aware that a willful failure to appear at such times as directed by the Court is punishable as a separate offense.
